The APM® is an affordable, compact, portable, battery powered audio amplifier having special characteristics for sensing the low frequency pressure pulses of the cardio vascular system and the sound of respiration.

Respiration and/or pulse sounds are detected by a sensitive microphone unit from an esophageal stethoscope tube or chest piece cup, and are amplified and presented audibly from a speaker, and visually by a flashing red indicator light.

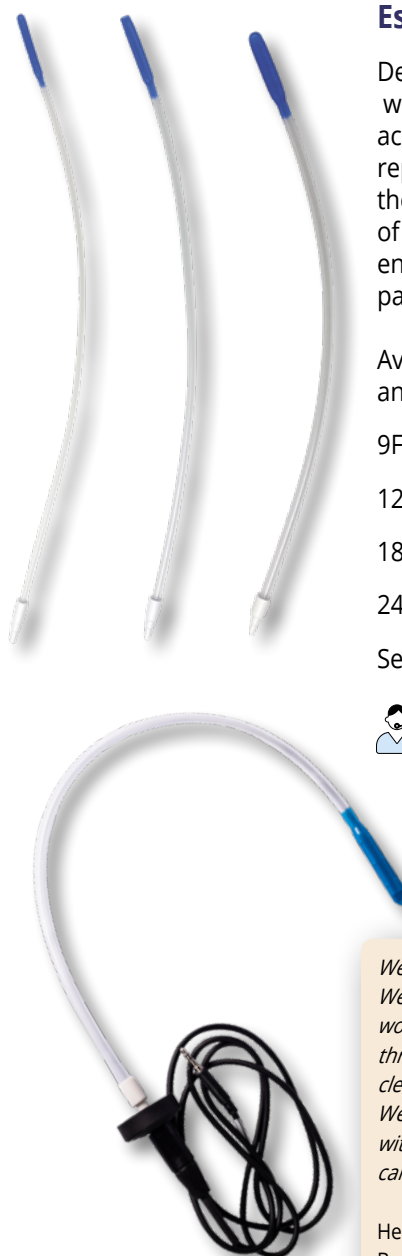
