STANDARDIZING MACHINES

At a high level, all anesthesia machines and vaporizers work the same way a series of systems working together to deliver anesthesia to the patient. But anesthesia machines and vaporizers from different manufactures have slightly different designs. For example, a critical component like a flush valve could be located in a different area.
